## French Polynesia

Comprising over 100 islands divided into several groups — the Society Islands that include Tahiti, Moorea, and Bora Bora; the Tuamotus; the Marquesas; and the Australs — French Polynesia is known for its warm, outgoing people and colorful, multifaceted culture. Its white-sand beaches and striking lava rock formations create stunning panoramas. The cuisine is a delicious mix of French specialties like fresh-baked baguettes and local traditions including a feast cooked in an underground oven. Spectacular diving awaits in the atolls of the Tuamotu Archipelago. Polynesia is also home to major producers of black pearls, so the shopping is irresistible!

## Fiji

Truly a land of enchantment, the Fiji Islands are bejeweled with turquoise lagoons, waterfalls you can swim underneath, thousands of miles of beaches, more than 300 species of native orchids, and tropical forests perfumed by wild frangipani blossoms. There are coral gardens ideal for snorkeling, and dramatic multi-colored coral walls for spectacular diving. Parrots wing their way through the trees, while turtles nest on the beaches. As you visit the villages and explore the markets, you'll be struck by the Fijians' kind and generous nature. No wonder Fiji is considered one of the world's most romantic places.

## The Kingdom of Tonga

Never colonized by an outside group, the 176 islands of Tonga remain an independent monarchy with an intriguing, homogenous culture. Most Tongans speak English, and they are known for their genuine welcome. Divers and snorkelers can explore caves and grottoes as well as reefs where the water is crystal clear. Ashore, there's flat terrain just right for biking past vanilla and pineapple farms, while some islands offer limestone plateaus traced by hiking trails. From late July into September, the whale watching among these islands is exceptional.
